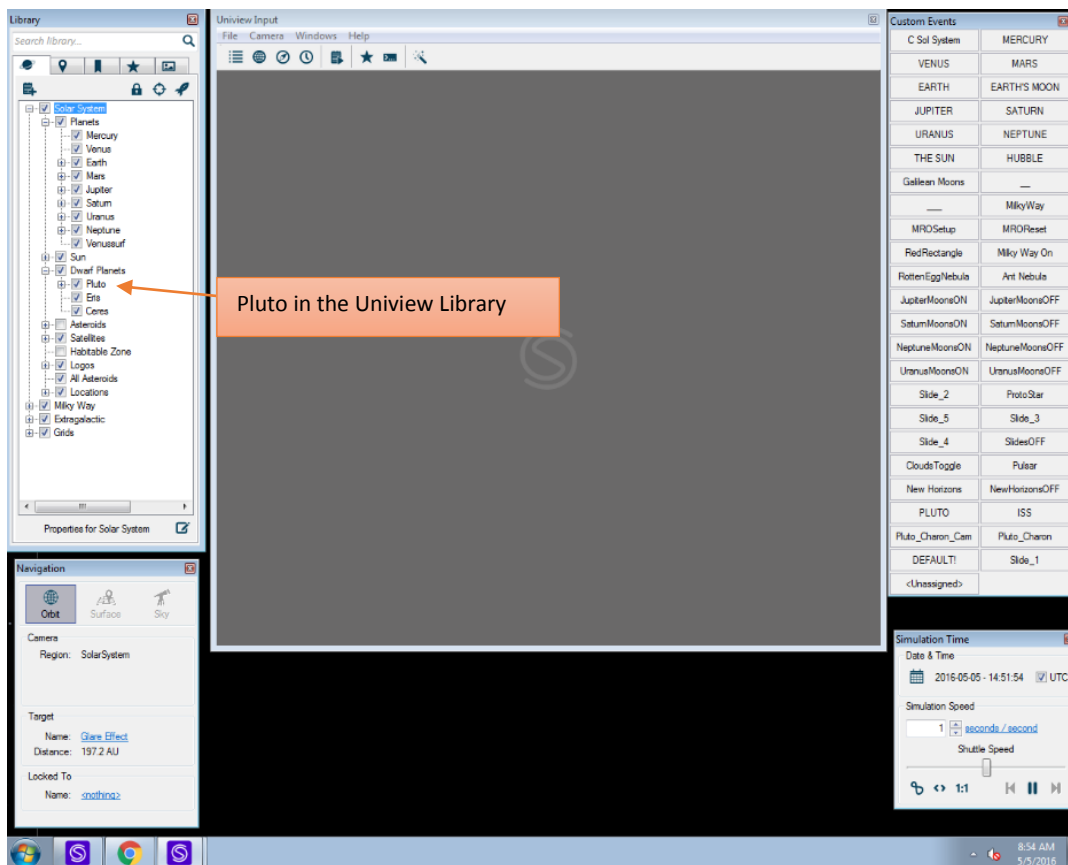
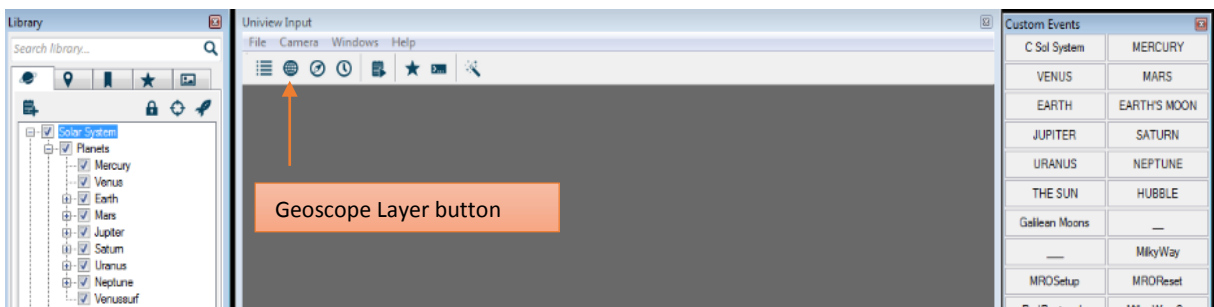


Uniview: Loading the New Horizons Layer on Pluto

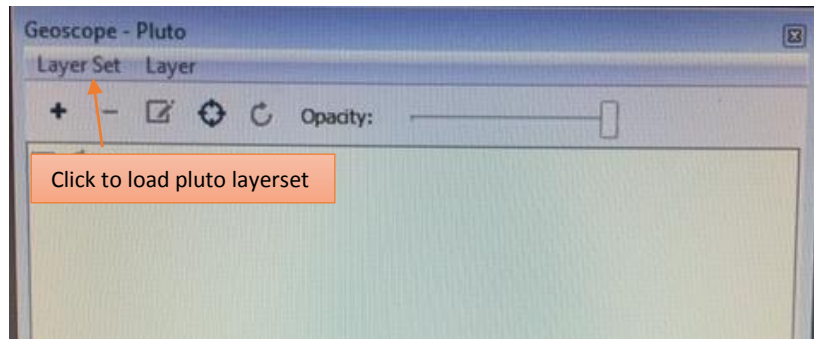
1. Jump to Pluto using the Library on the left hand side of your screen.
 - a. To find Pluto in the Library – expand “Solar System” then “Dwarf Planets”



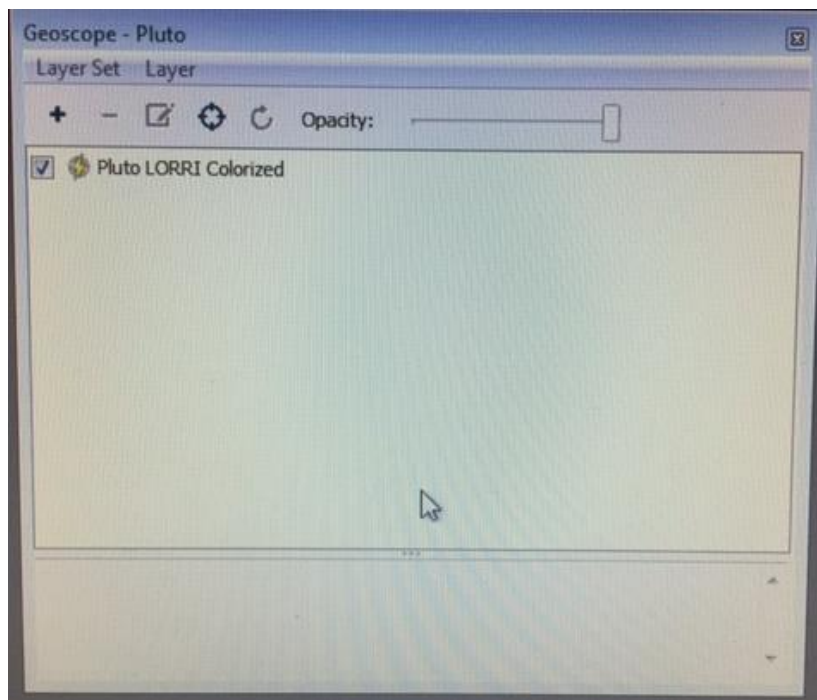
- b. To Jump to the Pluto, right click it, and then select “Jump To.” This is will bring the old model of Pluto up on the Orbits Table.
2. When you are at Pluto, make sure the name is still highlighted in the Library.
 3. Then, you need to load the Geoscope Layer.
 - a. First, click on the wire globe in the upper left of the Uniview Input window



- b. This will cause a window to pop up. Click Layer Set in the upper left of the popup and then click Load from the drop-down menu.



- c. This will bring up file explorer pop-up. Select pluto.layerset and then "open" in the lower right hand corner.
- d. Once you do this, it will show you the layerset you have loaded



4. Close the pop-up. Now you will have the New Horizons images loaded over Pluto. They will come up automatically when you go to Pluto for the rest of the time Uniview is open. Once Uniview is closed, the layerset will need to be re-loaded.
